Investment Objective

The FundX Sustainable Impact Fund (SRIFX) seeks to provide investors with long-term capital appreciation.

Investment Strategy

The Sustainable Impact Fund applies two selection screens to invest in diversified stock funds that have strong recent returns and strong environmental, social and governance (ESG) ratings.

The first screen uses a time-tested Upgrading strategy to own funds with strong recent returns. Funds that have done well recently may continue to do well in the coming months or even years.

Effective ESG Integration

The second screen integrates environmental, social and governance (ESG) factors into FundX's Upgrading approach. This non-financial performance indicator is applied as a risk measure in an effort to generate long-term competitive investment performance and positive societal impact.

The Funds employ an "Upgrading" strategy whereby investment decisions are based on near-term performance, however, the Funds may be exposed to the risk of buying underlying funds immediately following a sudden, brief surge in performance that may be followed by a subsequent drop in market value. The Funds invest in underlying funds and these underlying funds may invest in securities of small companies, which involve greater volatility than investing in larger, more established companies, or they may invest in foreign securities, which involve greater volatility and political, economic and currency risks and differences in accounting methods; these risks are greater for investments in emerging markets. Some underlying funds may use derivatives, which involve risks different from, and in certain cases, greater than the risks presented by more traditional investments.
